




Liberty Player—Changing Level Option

Switching your view to show Changing Level will allow you to adjust the volume level of individual channels.

1. From the Windows desktop, **OPEN** (Double-Click) the Liberty Player icon.





2. The program starts, displaying an empty Player window.
3. To locate the recording needed, click on the **OPEN FILE** button  or click FILE+OPEN from the Pull-Down Menu in the upper right corner of the screen. The recording is usually located under C:\Liberty Recordings. You can also search for the recording by clicking the **Find in Files** button. 

4. Your recording should now be loaded, click on the **GREEN Play** button  to play the recording.

5. To playback audio/video from a point where you have inserted a **BOOKMARK**, double-click on the **BOOKMARK** and the recording will jump to that time.

6. To playback audio/video from a point where you have inserted a **BOOKMARK**, double-click on the **BOOKMARK** and the recording will jump to that time.

7. To switch to Changing Level view, click View/Changing Level.

8. To Pause the playback, click on the  button. To Stop the playback, click on the  button.
