

Liberty Court Recorder: What's New

Liberty Court Recorder v8.7:

- ◆ The Recorder's Remote Conferencing facility has been significantly enhanced with a number of new capabilities and features including but not limited to:
 - ⇒ Alert operator that new participants have arrived in the Lobby.
 - ⇒ Improved identification of people using phones to call into the system.
 - ⇒ Participant is now removed from the Lobby list if they have been taken by another Conference Manager.
 - ⇒ Added a column to the Lobby list that displays the court start time associated with the participant.
 - ⇒ The ability to filter the list of participants in the Lobby list by selecting a court or courtroom.
- ◆ Support for Network Device Interface (NDI) cameras as full-time video sources.
- ◆ Another full screen view, called Status Info Window, is available. This allows for monitoring the recording.
- ◆ Support for "Q-SYS", "AJA HELO Plus" and "Magewell Ultra Stream" IP devices.
- ◆ Text can be included on the frame for each video stream.
- ◆ Ability to enlarge the selected video in General Video Window.
- ◆ Ability to mute the broadcast audio.
- ◆ Support for the use of CTRL + Backspace (delete the previous word) and Ctrl + Shift + Backspace (delete to the beginning of the line) keystrokes in the text fields.

Liberty Court Recorder v8.6:

- ◆ The Recorder's Remote Conferencing facility has been significantly enhanced with a number of new capabilities and features including but not limited to:
 - ⇒ Support for SIP connection dial-out.
 - ⇒ Increasing the stability of the conference for low Internet speed.
 - ⇒ The ability to assign multiple different Roles to the same recording channel
 - ⇒ Support for sharing the Recorder's screen during the conference.
 - ⇒ The ability to place people directly into Conference Mode when they are moved from the Lobby.
 - ⇒ The ability to rename the Private Rooms.
 - ⇒ The ability to mute individual local audio channels when the virtual court is active.
 - ⇒ Save event log of remote conferencing in the dcr file.
 - ⇒ The ability to block just the video of a participant.
- ◆ Ability to use CSV files for pre-defined bookmarks.
- ◆ Reconnecting with an IP device during recording.
- ◆ The Broadcast button is now shown in Toolbar control.

Liberty Player: What's New

Liberty Player v2.6:

- ◆ Support for recording files created in V8.6 of the Liberty Court Recorder has been implemented.
- ◆ Ability to use simplified input for jump to time.
- ◆ Ability to undo and redo operations when working with bookmarks.
- ◆ A new option settings dialog allows for the customization of local keyboard shortcut keys along with the introduction of additional functions that can be controlled using keyboard shortcuts.
- ◆ The program now allows you to minimize any of the individual program Windows by clicking on the standard "minimize" button. Individually minimized Windows are shown on the lower left portion of the Desktop and may be restored by double-clicking on the Window icon.
- ◆ The Video Window facility has been enhanced in several ways. All of the recorded video streams may now be shown in a single "General" Video Window. This General Window may be resized and stretched both laterally and horizontally, according to the user's purpose. The General Video Window can be resized to create a column of video playback streams that can be placed on one side or the other of the monitor, or the General Video Window can be resized to create a row of video playback streams that may be positioned at the top or the bottom of the monitor. In addition to the General Video display Window, the user can click on any individual video playback stream and isolate any of the streams into an individual display Window that can be resized according to the user's needs.
